Dear Mayor Montgomery:

I am in receipt of your recent letter. You have requested an opinion as to the term of the Town's Election Commission. You have stated that there are three persons on the Commission. Two members were appointed this year and one was appointed last year.

SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS, 1976, Section 5-15-90, provides in part:

. . . the terms of the members (of the municipal election commission) shall be six years except of those first appointed one shall serve a term of four years and one a term of two years.
