In response to your request for an opinion from this Office regarding whether or not a referendum must be conducted before a municipal governing body can agree to the creation by the county of a special tax district for water and sewer services within the municipality pursuant to Section 4-9-30(17), CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, as amended, my opinion is that a referendum must be conducted because Article VIII, Section 16 requires all cities and counties to hold a referendum before establishing and operating gas, water, sewer, electric, transportation or other public utility systems and plants.
