This letter is to confirm our earlier telephone conversation and in response to your letter. You have stated that Abbeville County School District No. 60 is preparing to have Trustee elections. You inquired if it was possible to not open all of the polling areas in the county within the school district area, but only as many polling areas as needed.

As I informed you in our telephone conversation, it would be necessary to open all the polling areas within the school district area. It would not be possible to select only certain polling areas to be open. South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, Sections 7-7-910; 7-7-930; [South Carolina Constitution, Article II, Section 4](#).
