In response to your request for an opinion from this Office regarding a street light assessment made by a municipality upon subdivision property owners outside the corporate limits, my opinion is that the municipality is authorized to make such an assessment pursuant to Section 5-7-60, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, as amended; <u>cf.</u>, § 5-31-1910, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, as amended. Such an assessment may be made as to all of the property owners who benefit thereby, notwithstanding their opposition to the street light for which the assessment is made. 14 McQUILLIN MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS §§ 38.26, 38.31 and 38.62 (1970).
