Dear Mr. Collins:

You have requested an opinion as to the possible change in the status of the Spartanburg County Historic Preservation Commission. An earlier opinion dated March 4, 1977, had concluded that the Commission was a political subdivision of the state. However, pursuant to the 1975 Home Rule legislation (see Editor's Note to [§ 4-9-20, 1976 Code of Laws](#)), certain entities were permitted to come under the jurisdiction and control of the counties. This is what has happened with the Spartanburg County Historic Preservation Commission and it is the opinion of this Office that the Commission is now an integral part of Spartanburg County.
