Pursuant to your inquiry of Mr. Barker of this office:

1. Is the application fee refundable regardless of whether the application is approved or denied?

[S.C. Code § 40-53-90](#) does not discriminate between approved or disapproved applications. Therefore this fee is not refundable to either category of applicant.

2. Do you have to be a resident of South Carolina to obtain in interns license?

[S.C. Code § 40-53-100](#) authorizes applications for licenses by non-residents. Caution must be taken to insure the satisfaction of [S.C. Code § 40-51-70](#) other than residency. An application for an original or renewal license could include an internship license.
