Dear Representative White:

In your letter of October 6, 1982 which this office received on October 11, 1982, you requested that we advise you as to whether the scheduling of a referendum in Jasper County should have been approved by the Jasper County Council. The Jasper County School Board did not obtain council's approval before scheduling the referendum. My understanding is that the purpose of the referendum is to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds by the Jasper County Board of Education.

Neither the general statutes of this state nor the laws applicable only to Jasper County appear to require county council's approval of a referendum of this kind. See Article X Section 17, Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, as amended; Sections 4-9-70, 11-27-50 and 59-71-10, et seq. of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended. If we may be of further assistance, please let us know.
