Dear Mr. Gilstrap:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to the authority of the Greenville County Council to adopt the National Fire Prevention Code in its entirety, my opinion is that it is so authorized pursuant to [Section 6-9-60, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA](#), 1976, (Cum.Supp.), which provides in pertinent part as follows:

Municipalities and counties are authorized to adopt by reference only the latest editions of the following nationally known codes for regulation of construction within their respective jurisdictions:

. . . Standard Fire Prevention Code, . . .
