You have recently asked this Office about the status of the May 27, 1980 Budget and Control Board decision concerning the Roberts S. Tate, Jr. grievance appeal.

Any actions concerning the academic personnel of institutions of higher education, taken pursuant to the State Employee Grievance Procedures Act by the State Employee Grievance Committee or the State Budget and Control Board, would be ultra vires acts after May 22, 1980, the effective date of the exemption.

You might want to advise the Board to reconsider its decision of May 27, 1980, in view of the exemption and the May 28, 1980 opinion (copy attached).
