Dear Representative Brandt:

You have requested the opinion of this Office as to the method of filling a vacancy on the Allendale County School Board. Act 233, Acts and Joint Resolutions of South Carolina, 1979, provides for the election and terms of the members of the Allendale County Board of Education; however, no law specifically provides for the filling of vacancies on this Board. Thus, any vacancy on this Board should be filled by the Governor pursuant to §§ 1-3-220 and 4-11-20 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976). See 1970-71 Op.'s Att'y. Gen., No. 3036, page 325.
