Dear Mr. Bell:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to the effect of a proviso in the 1980-81 General Appropriations Act upon the authority of the Dorchester County Council to reduce the salary of a part time assistant attendance supervisor, my opinion is that it does not prohibit such action by the Council.

The proviso reads as follows:

Provided, further, that for the fiscal year 1980-81 the local supplement to salaries of county School Lunch Supervisors and School Attendance Supervisors shall not be reduced below supplements paid in 1979-80. Act R-585, § 28 of 1980.

The proviso prohibits the reduction of local supplements below the 1979-80 level with respect to school lunch supervisors and school attendance supervisors; it does not expressly or, in my opinion, impliedly include part time assistants to those individuals.
