Ms. Ashworth of our Office asked me to research the questions presented to her by you on behalf of Comptroller General Morris. I understand the questions to be as follows:

1. How would the unexpired term of the present Treasurer of York County be filled should he resign?
2. (a) On what date would the County Auditors elected in the 1978 general election take office?
- (b) Has our Office issued an opinion on when Bob Jeter's term of office in Richland County expires?

I am presently researching the law and investigating the facts with reference to question 1. With regard to 2.(a) and 2.(b). I have enclosed a copy of a November 2, 1977 opinion written by Senior Assistant Attorney General Karen Henderson which may partially provide the answers you requested. However, I need to determine if there have been any subsequent acts or developments which would alter this opinion. Furthermore, I understand that Comptroller General Morris does not necessarily need a written opinion.
