This Office has reviewed the bid proposal of National Evaluation Systems, Inc., dated July 21, 1980, in response to the Educator Improvement Task Force, RFP, SC-EITF-002, together with the bid documents and other pertinent information.

It is the opinion of this Office that the Educator Improvement Task Force has complied in all respects with the bidding procedures and policies required by State law, and that the proposal of National Evaluation Systems, Inc., is properly responsive to the RFP. We note that the RFP was appropriately advertised, and direct invitations for responses were made to seven qualified testing and research organizations. We also note that responses from several of these organizations were received, although they advise that the time limitations for performance of the work resulted in determination that they did not intend to submit formal proposals.

Accordingly, it is our opinion that upon approval by the State Budget and Control Board an award of the contract may be properly made to National Evaluation Systems, Inc. As previously advised, we suggest that the proposed standard form of consueant contrice prepared by this Office should be used as the basic documents to be executed by the parties, and this Office will be happy to assist you in its preparation.
