Dear Judge Parker:

After discussing the matter over the telephone with you recently, I find that there is a statute which was adopted in 1979 and which provides that the salary for the judges of probate shall not be diminished during their terms of office. See Section 8-21-760, Code of Laws, 1976 (Supp.) This section was incorporated in the Code by Act No. 164 of 1979.

A previous statute (Section 11-23-1010) was adopted in 1976 and does not relate to the salary of the probate judge. The latter statute, of course, is controlling.
