Dear Mr. Hyman:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to the operation of [Section 12-59-10, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA](#), 1976, as amended, now that the provisions of the 'home rule' legislation are in effect, my opinion is that [Section 12-59-10](#), a general law, has been neither expressly nor impliedly repealed by the 'home rule' legislation and that, accordingly, the requirement set forth that the chairman of the county governing body may serve on the county forfeited land commission only if the county legislative delegation officially designates him to do so must be met. See generally, S.C.CONST. art. VIII, § 14(6) and art. X.
