We have reviewed the proposed amendment to Section 10-145.1 of the South Carolina Code of Laws and discerned no constitutional invalidity therein. It is not uncommon that a statute provide that a statute of limitations shall not run against an infant during a prescribed period. See, e.g., 54 C.J.S. Limitations of Actions § 235 at 262 (1948).
