I am in receipt of your recent letter in which you asked the following question:

Does state law allow precincts to be reorganized in an off-election year?

South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, as amended, Section 23-153 states that the General Assembly shall designate and establish voting precincts. These precincts are to contain 1,500 persons and any precinct containing more than this designated number may be altered at anytime.
