In my opinion, a prosecution of your client for violation of [Section 7512, Title 26 of the United States Code](#), is not an offense involving moral turpitude. I base this opinion upon the conclusion that there does not appear to be an intent to defraud the Government in this matter and upon the cases of [United States v. Reimer](#), 30 F.Supp. 767, 768, and [In re Kling](#), 108 Pa. 152, as well as consultation with personnel of the prosecuting staff who are familiar with the matter.
