Dear Mr. Smith:

Mr. McLeod has referred your recent letter to me for reply. I am enclosing the Attorney General's Opinion that you requested. [1962-63 Ops.Att'y.Gen., No. 1605, p. 188.] You have also requested that we verify this opinion as correct. The law stated in the opinion is still correct. However, there is one statement in the opinion which has changed. The opinion concerns South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, as amended, Section 21-4372 which requires that candidates for the board of trustees of School District No. 3 in York County file notice of candidacy fifteen days prior to the election. South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, as amended, Section 23-400.15 would now require this filing to be at least thirty days before the election.
