Dear Representative Hawkins:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to whether or not the Woodruff-Roebuck Water District is required to accept the lowest bid in purchasing motor vehicles for the District, my opinion is that it is not so required by any general law. Accordingly, unless the specific legislation creating the Commission or any amendment thereto (or any Commission rule

or regulation) imposes such a requirement, and my research indicates that it does not [see, 49 STAT. 2841 (1956)],¹ the Commission is not required to accept the lowest bid in purchasing motor vehicles. With kind regards,
