Dear Ms. Manigault:

Your letter of December 11, 1980, forwards copies of the indictment returned in the case of <u>State v. Jim Lewis</u>, and you inquire as to whether the offenses with which he is charged involve moral turpitude. Mr. Lewis has been indicted for assault with intent to kill, pointing a firearm and resisting arrest.

The offense of assault with intent to kill is a crime involving moral turpitude. The Supreme Court of South Carolina has so held in the case of <u>State v. Spinks</u>, 260 S.C. 410, 411, 196 S.E.2d 313.
