## Dear Paul:

Mr. McLeod assigned your letter of February 3, 1977, to me for answer. As per our telephone conversation, I am in complete agreement with you that food service management contracts are the type contracts for which bids must be invited pursuant to § 1–24, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1962, as amended. This Office is of the opinion that your suggestion that we secure copies of the contracts for food service management executed by Clemson, University of South Carolina, and the Citadel, three State institutions which did not invite bids pursuant to § 1–24, and determine the proper course of action based on the contracts is a good suggestion.
