Dear Senator:

Thank you for your letter of January 26, 1977, concerning the classified ad sent to you by your constituent. The ad offers for sale a key kit which 'will get you in any car in seconds.'

You are correct in your recollection as to the law precluding master keys. Section 16-303 prohibits the possession of any set of keys to unlock vehicles, etc., of a particular manufacturer which differs from keys issued by such manufacturer.

I am forwarding a copy of this letter to the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division, with the request that they please investigate this matter. I have been assured by them that this will be done.
