Dear Mr. Rawl:

In response to your request for an opinion from this office as to whether or not the provisions of Sections 42-531 et seq., CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1962, as amended, are affected by the provisions of Act No. 283 of 1975, the 'home rule' legislation, my opinion is that Sections 42-531 et seq. remain in effect until at least January 1, 1980, by virtue of Section 14-3717 of the Code (Cum. Supp.) which provides in part as follows:

All operations, agencies and offices of county government, appropriations and laws related thereto in effect on the date the change in form becomes effective shall remain in full force and effect . . . until repealed by the General Assembly, or until January 1, 1980, whichever time is sooner, . . .
