Dear Mr. Spivey:

I am in receipt of your recent letter. You have asked if a county political party can place additional requirements as to membership in a precinct club. I believe that the question you have asked is one that should be governed by the Republican Party Rules. However, I would refer you to South Carolina Code of Laws, 1962, as amended, Section 23-253 which authorizes the State Convention of any political party to add by party rules to the qualifications for membership in the party.
