Dear Solicitor Myers:

Thank you for your letter of March 11. Mr. McLeod has referred the same to me for response.

I have found no authority for or against the propriety of a solicitor's sending a jury list to a magistrate so that the magistrate may inform the solicitor of any favorable or unfavorable information concerning the jurors. The decision as to whether to follow this practice should be left to the discretion of the individual magistrate.
