Enclosed is a copy of an opinion which bears on the question of whether or not, pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 283 of 1975, the 'home rule' legislation, the Saluda County Council could abolish the office of county supervisor before January 1, 1980. While Saluda County does not operate under the council-administrator form of county government as Clarendon County does, nonetheless, the opinion expressed with regard to Clarendon County would apply to Saluda County as well since it does not have the council-supervisor form. Let me know if you need an opinion directed to Saluda County specifically.
