Dear Mr. Blease:

In connection with the issuance of bonds by Saluda County by a school district, it is my opinion that the outcome of the case before the Supreme Court at the present time should be awaited. That case concerns the validity of the postponement of the effective date of the financial article of the Constitution which was ratified at the last session of the General Assembly and which postponed the effective date of that amendment until December 1, 1977. If the outcome of the opinion is that the extension is valid, no vote will be required. Otherwise, a vote will be required on the issuance of bonds. Mr. Simons of Charleston, who has been retained, advised me that he had issued similar advices to some official in Saluda County.
