Dear Mr. Atkins:

Thank you for your letter of June 27, 1977, concerning the application of a statewide ethics commission over legislative and executive officials.

The problem has never arisen in this State, most probably for the reason that a separate ethics procedure is established in the South Carolina ethics law whereby legislative ethics are subject to the supervision of legislative bodies created for that purpose. In the light of a recent decision of the Supreme Court of this State entitled <u>State ex rel. McLeod v. Edwards, Governor</u>, I am uncertain where legislative powers vis-a-vis executive powers begin and end.
