## Dear Mr. Matthews:

You have requested my opinion on whether or not an individual may serve as a member of a board of trustees of a school district while at the same time serving as a member of the Agricultural Stabilization Committee without violating the dual officeholding provisions of the Constitution.

I advise that, in my opinion, this will not be in violation of the dual officeholding provisions for the reason that one of the positions (ASC) is not a State office and that under the applicable provision of the Constitution, he may occupy both offices.
