Dear Mr. Jordan:

You have requested an opinion as to the power of an employer to withdraw from the State Retirement System, and have cited Opinion No. 2364 (May 22, 1967) to the effect that such withdrawal is not permissible. I am not aware of any change in the Statute or of any other consideration which would change the conclusion reached by this Office in the 1967 opinion. Accordingly, I must advise you that unless and until the statute is changed, withdrawal of an employer from the System is not permissible.
