Dear Mr. Harper:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 41-33-80 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, the South Carolina Employment Security Commission is vested with authority to requisition monies from the Unemployment Trust Fund deposited in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of this State.

By the provision of Section 41-29-30 of the Code of Laws, the Commission is authorized to appoint an administrator to act as the chief executive officer of the Commission, which officer is vested with the exercise of the powers and authority of the Commission, subject to its direction.

The South Carolina Employment Security Commission has so duly appointed Mr. Robert E. David as Executive Director of the Commission, effective January 10, 1975.

I am of the opinion that Mr. Robert E. David is the proper and duly constituted authority under the provisions of the South Carolina Employment Security Law to make requisitions from the unemployment trust fund on behalf of the South Carolina Employment Security Commission. Under the provisions of Sections 41-29-70 and 41-29-100, the Commission may further delegate the authority of the Executive Director to other persons to requisition such funds under his immediate control and direction. The signatures of any such individual so designated shall be certified by the Commission.
