You have requested an opinion as to whether the York County Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse is an 'employer' pursuant to § 9–1–10(5), 1976 Code of Laws. The agency is a nonprofit corporation chartered in 1969. However, I am informed that it is funded entirely through public sources, namely, minibottle revenues, county taxes, and federal funds. It is thus the opinion of this Office that the above-named county is a service organization within the meaning of § 9–1–10(5) and therefore an 'employer' for retirement purposes.
