Dear Representative Granger:

In response to your request for an opinion as to whether the Greenville County Legislative Delegation or the Greenville County Council is the body responsible for recommending the appointment of the members of the Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority (Authority), according to the provisions of Act No. 1545 of 1968 [55 STAT. 3587 (1968)], the members of the Authority's governing body are supposed to be elected for terms of four years in special elections conducted by the county election commission and paid for by Authority funds. My research reveals that the 1968 legislation has not been amended to alter the method of selecting the members of the Authority's governing body.
