Dear Representative Granger:

In response to your request for an opinion as to whether the Greenville County Legislative Delegation or the Greenville County Council is the body responsible for recommending the appointment of the members of the Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority (Authority), according to the provisions of Section 3 of Act No. 688 of 1969 [56 STAT. 1303 at 1305 (1969)], the members of the Authority's governing body are supposed

to be appointed by the Governor upon the recommendation of the Legislative Delegations of Greenville, Anderson and Laurens Counties, such delegations acting as one entity. The legislative delegation is defined as all House members from the county involved plus all Senators involved, whether they be from a multi-county district or not.
