Dear Judge Lee:

In reference to your question concerning whether or not there is any state-wide statutory authority for dog control, please be advised that I am not familiar with any such statutes. Section 47–3–10, et seq., Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, authorizes the enactment of ordinances and the promulgation of regulations by individual counties as to dog control. However, according to your local officials, Georgetown County has not yet enacted any such dog control ordinances.
