Pursuant to your inquiry concerning the question of whether the Teacher Dismissal Act of 1974 is applicable to a county district superintendent who is named as such by his governing authority for general supervisory powers over the school district under its board of trustees, I advise that the Teacher Dismissal Act is not applicable to a supervisory and non-instructional position of this nature. See Sections 59-25-430, et seq., 1976 Code of Laws.
