As you requested, enclosed are copies of opinions concerning the holding of executive sessions pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, Sections 30-3-10 et seq., CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976. As far as your other inquiry is concerned, I think that the Kingstree City Council is authorized, although such action is not necessary, to pass a resolution to the effect that the City does not intend to pass favorably upon individual petitions to be annexed into the City pursuant to Section 5-3-150(3), CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, beyond those landowners presently abutting the corporate limits and presently receiving sewer and water services until such time as the contemplated expansion of the sewer and water facilities is completed.
