You have requested the opinion of this office as to whether the Authority can consider Mid-South Mortgage Company, Inc., and its development arm, Tandem Development, Inc. as a potential developer under your NOFA published in Columbia, Greenville, Charleston and Charlotte newspapers weekly during April, 1979. It is our opinion that you cannot.

From the facts as given to us, it appears that Mid-South did not respond in writing to the Authority by 5:00 p.m. on April 30, 1979 and is, therefore, not in compliance with your NOFA. The correspondence from Mid-South dated March 29, 1979 could not, of course, be in response to your NOFA because that NOFA had not then been published. The letter of May 3, 1979 from Mid-South is ineffective because it was not timely received. This office is of the opinion that the Authority would be derelict in its duty to all those companies which properly responded to the NOFA if it permitted Mid-South to be considered.
