Dear Governor Riley:

In response to your request for an opinion from my Office as to the constitutionality of an act of the General Assembly amending a 1967 act so as to further provide for the compensation of members of the Edgefield County Water and Sewer Authority, it is my opinion that such legislation is most probably violative of the 'no laws for a specific county' language of [Article VIII, Section 7 of the South Carolina Constitution](#) as interpreted by the South Carolina Supreme Court in [Torgerson v. Craver](#), 230 S.E.2d 228 (1976).
