Dear Dr. Liston:

You have requested an opinion of this Office as to whether your district may charge a fee of \$1.00 to persons parking on district owned land adjacent to the football stadium during games there.

Section 59-19-90(5) of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976) gives the board of trustees of a school district the authority to '[t]ake care of, manage and control the school property of the district . . ..' This provision should give the trustees authority to set a parking fee which is consistent with the trustees' duties of care, management and control.
