In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to whether or not you must resign as Acting Register of Mesne Conveyance of Charleston County before you can become a candidate for that office, my opinion is that there is no state law requiring you to resign first. As to any restrictions placed upon you by applicable federal laws, I would suggest that you contact the office of the Civil Service Commissioner in Washington, D. C., inasmuch as that office makes determinations as to the applicability of federal laws to non-federal employees. As to any restrictions placed upon you by county ordinance, I would suggest that you contact one of the Charleston County attorneys. With kind regards,
