Dear Ms. Gray:

The Federal Regulation to which you refer in your letter of January 27, 1978, is incorporated by reference into the South Carolina Unfair Trade Practices. Therefore, the cooling off period provided by that regulation, as well as other requirements, is the law in South Carolina.

As to your second inquiry, persons who have obtained their eighteenth birthday are <u>sui juris</u>. Married persons less than eighteen <u>may</u> under some circumstances enter into binding contracts.
