Dear Dr. Mullins:

You have asked advice as to whether policy statements or directives of the Budget and Control Board which are applicable to state employees need to be promulgated according to the requirements of the Administrative Procedures Act. As was stated in my letter to you of October 24, 1977, the term 'regulation' specifically excludes agency procedures applicable only to agency personnel. This policy statement should be filed with the Legislative Council for informational purposes and printed in the State Register, but as I read the law there is no requirement that they be subject to a public hearing and approval by the General Assembly.
