Mr. McLeod has referred your recent letter to me for reply. You have asked if a person must vote for all the candidates who offer at one election. Specifically, you have asked if a person must vote for all the candidates offering in an election for city council when there are three positions to be filled and eleven candidates. Pursuant to Section 7-13-1120, South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, a person may vote for one, two or three persons and his vote will be counted. However, if the elector should vote for more than three, the ballot would not be counted. Very truly yours,
