Dear Mr. Mathis:

In reply to your letter of April 7, 1978, this is to advise you that my research does not disclose any specific bonding requirement for the mayor, councilmen, clerk or administrative assistant of a municipality—with the exception of a fidelity bond required of the city manager or employees under a council-manager form of government—pursuant to Section 5-13-60, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976.

Further, I find no specific requirement that the bonds of your clerk and administrator are required to be filed in the office of the Secretary of State. Normally, the only bonds required to be filed are those that are required by law of state and county officers.
