Dear Mr. Price:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to the procedure to be used in appointing the members of the Stroud Memorial Hospital Commission (Commission), in my opinion, the Commission members are to be appointed by the Governor 'upon certification of their eligibility by a majority of the Greenville County Legislative Delegation, including the Senator' pursuant to Act No. 1239 of 1964 [53 STAT. 2866 (1964)], as amended. The Stroud Memorial Hospital District is a special purpose district within the meaning of Section 4-9-170, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, and, therefore, is outside the appointment power of the Greenville County Council even after January 1, 1980.
