## Dear Mr. Johnson:

You requested an opinion whether the Real Estate Commission would be justified in refusing to renew the license of a broker who is appealing an adverse ruling of the Real Estate Commissioner revoking his license. It is our opinion that the Commission is not justified in refusing to renew the license.

There is no provision of state law which provides a grounds for the Commission's refusing to renew the license of a licensee upon proper application. See, § 40-57-150(2), SOUTH CAROLINA CODE, 1976, and R 105-24 REAL ESTATE COMMISSION REGULATIONS. To refuse to renew this broker's license now would be improper in that it would attempt to accomplish indirectly what is not permitted under § 40-57-220, SOUTH CAROLINA CODE, 1976, namely, to revoke a license pending appeal.
