*1 Legislative Delegation continues to appoint the Williamsburg County Tax Collector until January 1, 1980.

Dear Sir:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to whether or not the Williamsburg County Legislative Delegation continues to appoint the Williamsburg County Tax Collector pursuant to Act No. 240 of 1947 [45 STAT. 482 (1947)], my opinion is that it does so continue to appoint him at least until January 1, 1980. See, § 4–9–170, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976. After that date, the Williamsburg County Council will be able to alter the method of appointment provided for in Act No. 240 of 1947 by virtue of language contained in Section 3 of Act No. 283 of 1975, the "home rule" legislation.
