Per our conversation of November 2, 1978, this is to inform you that pursuant to authority as set forth in §§ 46-7-10(5), (6) and 47-13-10 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended in accordance with § 1-23-130, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, that the Livestock-Poultry Health Division of Clemson University has the authority to promulgate an emergency regulation that would allow them to administer a fee of \$3 per animal for the agar gel immunodiffusion blood test (Coggins Test) for equine infectious anemia conducted in the Clemson Diagnostic Laboratory as required by Act #400, Acts and Joint Resolutions, 1978.
